**Contributions.** Briefly describe your involvement in advancing the knowledge or capability of the profession of landscape architecture in the last five years.

During the last five years, I have contributed to advancing the knowledge of the landscape architecture profession through the scholarship of teaching and learning in the design studio and through efforts related to community planning and design for sustainable development. Over that period, I have published nine refereed articles and authored twenty-six refereed conference presentations. My contributions have been presented in the United States and Internationally. Furthermore, I believe that one of my most significant contributions to the advancement of the profession was through the 2009 co-authored publication “Twenty-five years of *Landscape Journal*: an analysis of authorship and article content.”
